Gift Thoughts For Christmas

Gifts from your kitchen for the friends who have everything? A basket or box beautifully packed or wrapped, filled with home-made goodies perhaps a plum pudding, a fruit cake, mince pie, macaripan, fancy cookies or kuchen.

Minceman

In a 2-cup pan put 2 cups sugar, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 cup water, 1/2 cup fat, 1/2 cup flour.

Add 10 oz. Almond paste, mix all together with a wooden spoon. Color and shape as desired.

Lady Fingers

3 egg whites
1-3 cup powdered sugar
2 beaten egg yolks
1 teaspoon Baker's vanilla
1-3 cup Pillsbury flour
Pinch salt. Mix, bake 8 minutes.

Fruit Pie

Bake a simple light sponge cake in a shallow biscuit tin or dripping pan, and when cold turn out on the moulding board and cut into small dominos or diamonds. They should be about 1/2 inch in depth. Split each one and spread jelly or frosting between the layers, then ice tops and sides with different tinted icings, pale green flavored with pistachio, pale pink with rose, yellow with orange, white with almond.

Candied violets, bits of citron cut in fancy shapes, candied cherries and angelica may all be utilized in making pretty designs in decoration.

Fondant

3 cups of granulated sugar
1 cup of boiling water

Put all ingredients over a low fire. When it starts to boil all over, cover, let boil 10 minutes, remove cover, continue boiling until it reaches the soft ball stage, when tried in cold water. When the mixture starts to boil, take a cloth wrung out of cold water and wipe sides of pan, when the grains have formed. Run a large platter in cold water, pour fondant carefully in stream. When cool burn edges of the mass towards the center and continue until mass begins to thicken and go white. Let fondant stand for at least an hour to ripen.

May be used the next day but is better after several days. Cover with a cloth wrung out of cold water, and the fondant will keep indefinitely.

Fondant may be used white or delicately colored with vegetable color or chocolate. Flavor with Bakers flavoring. Dip in milk, chocolate or just the colored bonbons. This fondant never fails to be compatible with the best candies.

Chocolate Peppermints

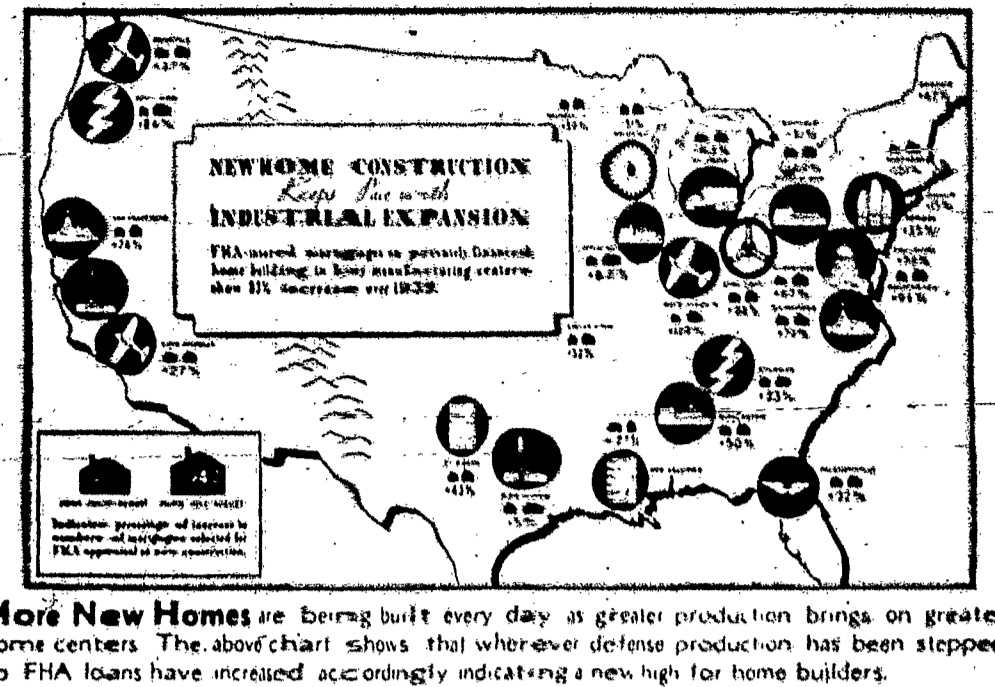
Melt a little fondant and flavor it to taste with essence of peppermint, leech the mixture white or tint very delicately with green or pink color-waste. With a teaspoon drop the mixture onto waxed paper to make rounds of the same size—about one inch and a quarter in diameter. Let these stand in a cool place about one hour. Put about a cup of fondant in a double boiler, add two ounces of chocolate and a teaspoonful of boiling water, then stir (over hot water) until the fondant and chocolate are melted and evenly mixed. Gather, then drop the peppermints, one by one, into the chocolate mixture, and remove them with the fork to a piece of oil cloth, let stand until the chocolate is set when they are ready to use.

Stuffed Dates—Chocolate Dipped

Cut chink dates open on one side and remove the seeds. Fill the open space in the dates with a strip of preserved ginger or pineapple, chopped nuts or chopped nuts mixed with white or chocolate fondant. Press the dates into a compact form to keep in the filling, then dip them, one by one, in "Dot" Chocolate.

Chocolate Cooled Almonds

Select nuts that are plum at the ends. Use them without blanching. Brush to remove the dust. Melt "Dot" Chocolate and when cooled properly drop the nuts, one at a time, into the center of it; push the nuts under with the fork, then drop onto waxed paper or oil cloth. In removing the fork make a design in the top of each nut. These are easily prepared and are particularly good.

Better Homes Better Living

Optical illusion is a valuable device when applied to house painting as a means of correcting bad proportions.

Veteran painters and decorators, for example, know that if the house seems too high for its length, a light roof color makes the house appear lower.

When the house has shutters it is sometimes desirable to paint the shutters of the upper story the same color as the roof. This aid to bring the roof line visually lower, as the eye will travel to the bottom of the dark shutters. The remaining shutters should be painted the color of the body of the house unless personal taste dictates otherwise.

This is just one of the many methods by which color may be used to correct bad proportions. Paint houses both inside and out may be arranged under the Modernization Credit Plan of the Federal Housing Administration.

Wise Planning of Bedrooms

Prospective home builders to arrange bedrooms with special consideration for privacy. Bedrooms should open directly on a common hall or on a room. Wise planning of the opening in bedrooms is vitally important to insure proper placing of beds and other furniture. Adequate ventilation is essential, and sunlight should be afforded at some time during the day.

CHAPTER NINE

It is impossible to give definite rules for tipping, because it all depends upon where you go, and upon what order of service.

In restaurants, if three or four friends were lunching or dining with you, you would give the waiter 10 per cent of the bill unless the total is very small in which case you might make it 15 per cent. If you are having a party of ten or twelve or more, 10 per cent should be quite enough divided between the waiters who serve you. In addition to this you perhaps give a tip of from 5 to 10 per cent to the head waiter. If the waiter takes particular pains to have the service efficient or if he treats you as an especial person give 10 or the other hand if he does nothing for you, you give him nothing.

As I have said, no definite rule of tipping is possible, but a reasonable rule is of minimum 10 per cent up to 25 cents for one person in any smart restaurant for a bill of less than \$2. 20 cents up to \$2 and 10 per cent above that amount—counting various gratuities at 5 cents, 10 per cent of \$3.10, 35 cents.

In a simpler restaurant 25 cents whether for one or two, for a bill of \$1.50 to \$2.00. It always seems unfair that tips given to waitresses are apt to be less than those given to waiters. Twenty-five cents for two persons at a table (not a cocktail party) is fair for three and 50 cents for four or five.

Other Hotel Tips: 25 cents for carrying bags to room; 25 cents for porter for bringing trunk to room; 10 cents to bell boy for carrying newspapers, packages, telegrams, etc.; 25 cents a room a day to chambermaid; 25 cents for checking a woman's wrap in the dressing room; 10 cents for the King's room's coat and hat; 25 cents for the room's hair dresser, manicure, Turkish bath, swimming pool, beauty specialist, and taxicab; Rates on arrival amounts—10 cents for a check of 5 cents or less; 15 cents for a total of 5 to 25 cents; 20 cents for a total of \$1.00 to \$2.00; 25 cents for \$2.00 to \$3.00; and 10 per cent above this amount.

On Trains: To the porter from 25 to 50 cents for a night or a day and 15 cents for a total of 75 to 100 cents; 25 cents for a night or a day or 150 for a day and night for a compartment or traveling room in dining car; 25 cents for a night or a day for 100 to 200 cents; 25 cents for 200 to 300 cents; 25 cents for 300 to 400 cents; 25 cents for 400 to 500 cents; 25 cents for 500 to 600 cents; 25 cents for 600 to 700 cents; 25 cents for 700 to 800 cents; 25 cents for 800 to 900 cents; 25 cents for 900 to 1000 cents.

Try Crown Roast For Christmas

Crown Roast For Special Occasion

If you want something quite special for your Christmas dinner, a crown roast of lamb will please you. The rib section is shaped into a crown with the ends of the ribs pointing upward and outward. Paper frills, potato or carrot balls or fruit can be used to decorate these French rib roasts. A stuffing may be cooked with the roast. In that case, protect the ribs ends from charring by wrapping them with pieces of salt pork. You do not use a stuffing; place the crown in the pan with the ribs ends downward. Before serving, fill the center of the crown with potato balls, cauliflower cooked whole or other vegetables.

To Roast Lamb

To roast lamb, season the meat with salt and pepper and place it, fat side up on a rack in an open roasting pan. Do not add water and do not cover. Place in slow oven (300° F) and roast until done. Allow thirty to thirty-five minutes per pound for cooking a roast in which the bones have not been removed. If the crust has been boiled and rolled, allow forty to forty-five minutes per pound for the roasting.
