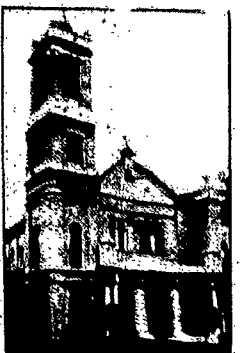

## PROCEEDS OF PAPERS' CONTEST TO AID STATUE PROJECT IN CAPITAL

The contest for the erection of a statue of the Virgin Mary in the National Catholic Welfare Conference is now in its final stages. The contest is being conducted by the National Catholic Welfare Conference.

Contestants are asked a total of 20 questions dealing with American history. The questions are being printed in the participating papers over a period of eleven weeks. The contest began last Sunday. There are rewards for early entry in the contest and prompt submission of answers to the questions. A total of \$5,000 is being offered in cash awards. The grand prize is \$2,500 which will increase to \$5,000 if the winner is an early entry. The first prize is \$1,000 and the second prize is \$500. There are four prizes of \$250 each and one hundred of \$100 each.
