Mrs. Sanger Wins As White Race Dwindles

Some thirty years ago the noted French physician, Andre Stegell, journeyed to New Zealand, then known as the "white paradise" to see for himself what the atmosphere of that country had accomplished under the leadership of Mr. Sidden. As a result of this journey the Frenchman published a highly complimentary volume, "Theocracy in New Zealand" regarding the conditions he discovered. That British New Zealand he considered as ideal New Zealand. He pointed out that the population was as general as the conditions.

In more recent years, however, less has been heard of the things praised by Stegell. Plainly, the population of New Zealand is concerned as to what is to be a dangerous symptom of the reduction in the number of births, a problem likewise existing in Australia. The fate of both countries in this regard is a warning proof of the overpopulation of natural resources, a veritable peril for what is today an international issue threatening the future of the major countries of the world.

None of these conditions exist in either of the two Dominions.

Population statistics from New Zealand show why the leaders of that country have cause for alarm. According to recent figures the birth rate among the white population in 1933 was 149 per thousand. Among the Maoris of the country a native population at the time nearly nearing extinction the birth rate was 425 per thousand. Thus the Maori birth rate was more than double the white rate. The Maoris, however, are steadily dying out.

Of the total Maori population of New Zealand 36,000 are over 14 years of age. On the other hand the white Maoris are only 10,000. In other words, the white population is decreasing at a rate of one-third every year.
