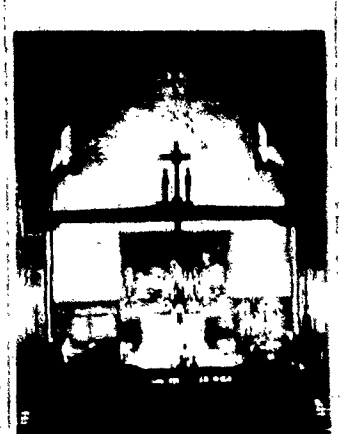
Impressive Scout Sunday Services In Geneva Marked By Eagle Badge Awards
