**BRITISH NUNS IN FRANCE SENT TO INTERMENT CAMP**

LONDON—A traveler from Portugal told the Daily Express here how men took off their hats reverently as 200 British nuns were marshalled on a Paris station, en route for Evian internment camp.  
 They had been removed from their convents by order of Hitler, the report says, and they arrived in little groups, each nun clutching a small bundle.  
 "It was their quiet dignity, as they walked to the prison train between the red-grey B.E. men which was the respect of the Parisians," the observer said. A few were weeping, and the older nuns comforted them.  
 Besancon internment camp is a 30-year-old fortress on the French side of the Swiss frontier. Red Cross authorities say that conditions have greatly improved there.
