NEW YORK.—(N. C.)—Americans are now faced "with the threat of the Double Cross" and in order to dispel the danger they must take up the Cross of Christ, declared the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Fulton J. Sheen.

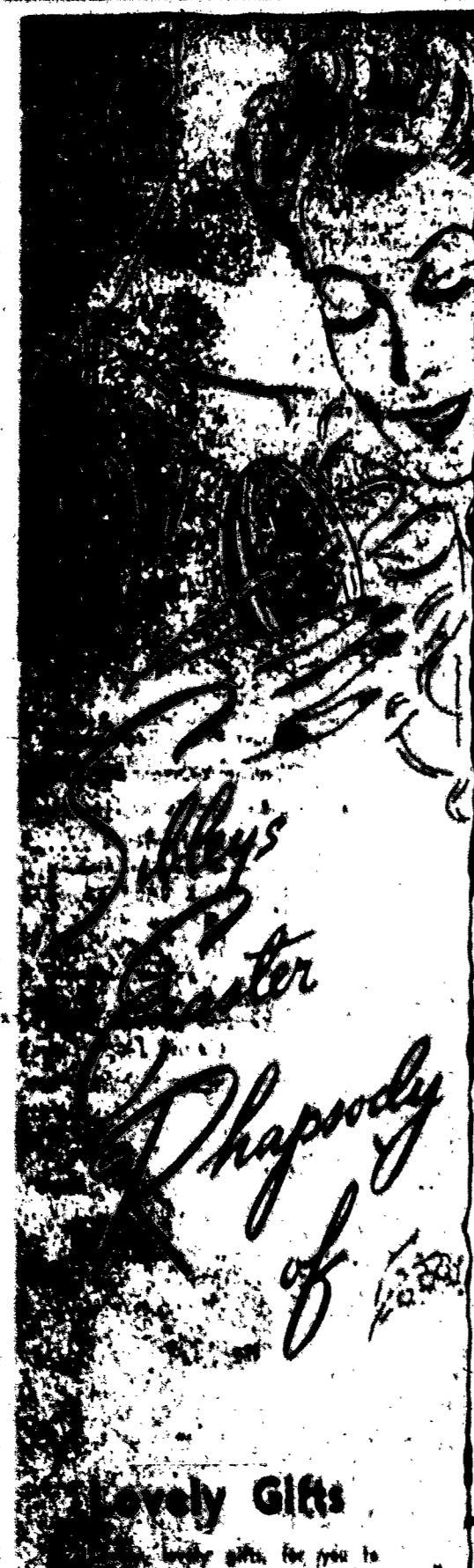
