Demonstration Scheduled At St. Bridget's

The CATHOLIC COURIER'S "School of Cookery" visits St. Bridget's parish tonight for the first time. In carrying out its extensive program, the demonstration will be given twice next week. On Tuesday, April 29 it will be presented at Holy Cross parish, 79 Latin Road and on Thursday it will be given at Our Lady of Good Counsel parish hall on Ardenstone.

The tonight's demonstration there will be some tasty desserts plus that ever popular favorite, spaghetti and meat sauce. The complete menu includes:

GLAZED STRAWBERRY PIE
 1 1/2 cups strawberries
 1 1/2 cups water
 2 cups sugar
 2 1/2 T cornstarch
 1/2 t salt
 1 T shortening
 Whole fresh strawberries
 Baked pie shell

Crush 1 c strawberries, add water and cook until soft. Strain and measure 1 1/2 of the juice. Mix sugar, cornstarch, salt and juice and bring to the boiling point. Cook until clear, add shortening. Spread a thin layer of cream filling over bottom of pie shell. Fill with whole fresh berries. Pour hot glaze a tablespoon at a time over the fruit. Cool. Serve whipped cream.

TUNA CROQUETTES
 1 1/2 cups milk
 1/2 cup soft bread crumbs
 1/2 teaspoon chopped parsley
 1 egg
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 1/2 cup medium white sauce
 1 egg yolk
 2 tablespoons mushrooms
 Salt and pepper

Cook together in a sauce pan the white sauce, peas, butter, mushrooms, salt and pepper. Pour over croquettes. Serves 4.

Spring Brings Need For Many Repair Jobs

The smoke from thousands of back-yard brush fires officially signals the end of Winter for the home owner.

More than the arrival of the first robin or the sight of the first crocus, the repair urge is the annual forerunner of Spring. After months of Winter inactivity, the average home owner is impatient for the first snow to melt so he can start the many repairs he has planned.

The exterior of the house usually is the first thing considered when the owner starts planning his Spring improvements.

Painting
 Architectural deficiencies are sometimes overcome by proper color treatment and expert landscaping. Two-color paint combinations may aid in making attractive an otherwise dull exterior. More important even than the value of added beauty is the value of added protection which paint gives to wood, metal and plaster surfaces.

Careful inspections sometimes reveal small defects which may be repaired inexpensively, often by the home owner himself. Where conditions are found such as loose bricks or siding, loose chimneys or weak porch supports, repairs should be made at once. Repairs of this type are eligible for financing under the Modernization Credit Plan of the Federal Housing Administration.

Interior Repairs Eligible
 Many repairs and improvements on the inside of the house may also be financed under the FHA plan. The inconvenience of an out-of-date bathroom may be overcome by new fixtures, gleaming tiles, and modern appliances, which good taste dictates today are easily substituted for old fixtures and under the FHA plan the cost may be paid in easy monthly payments.

The interested home owner will always find things to do which will improve the home. An upstairs porch closed in, will make an extra bedroom. A recessed place of wasted attic space, put in at small expense, will add livability and provide a playroom for growing children. Conversion of the average cellar into a playroom is often a simple matter.

'Raisin Week' To Be Observed May 11-17

Don't let Raisin Week—May 11 to 17—slip by you without deriving your full measure of pleasure from it.

Just as the Christmas celebration means bringing out some of the treasures of yesteryears—loved ornaments for the tree and mementoes of the past—so the observance of Raisin Week reminds us of some of the old recipes that have been passed down from our grandmothers.

Here's one that dates back almost to the very first Raisin Week observed in 1909. So popular has it been that an editor has published this old recipe no less than seven times in her food column. Readers who have tried it once request it again if they lose the recipe.

Easy to make, inexpensive, grand in flavor, moist to the last crumb, you'll love it.

Beauty Is Your Business

Interior decoration isn't a pastime for the rich. It's a duty of every homemaker. Good taste in decorating your home will accomplish more for you than lavish spending.

Beauty in the home is not dependent upon the expenditure of large sums of money but rather upon the exercise of intelligence. It is not so much what you use that makes your home attractive and individual as the way you use things. Beauty is found in cotton as well as silk. It may be a different type of beauty but it is nevertheless, artistically correct. Home decorating should be the reflection of good taste and art in the home can be adjusted to any purse.

The homemaker's heart must be in the art of the home if that home is to reflect the joy of living. I have seen dirty tenements of two or three rooms, turn under the magic wand of good taste, into clean, cheerful and attractive homes. I have seen cold, dreary rooms made to reflect warmth and joy by merely applying the right type of paint or paper to the walls. Homes are the reflection of our personalities.

In interior decoration, contrary to the usual procedure in life, we begin at the top and work down. The next time you call a painter to consult about one of your rooms, notice that the ceiling is the first place to attract his attention. Although we sometimes use date ceilings used to fashionable advantage, it is usually advisable to have the ceiling the lightest value in the room. Floors should be the darkest.

And arrange round patties. Place under broiler and broil 2 minutes or until delicately browned. Turn, arrange thick slices of tomato that have been sprinkled with salt and pepper, and grated cheese on each and broil until cheese is melted and potatoes and cakes are brown. Arrange on platter.

Mom's Little Helpers

GLASS FOR BAKING Baking dishes of glass or pottery are best because you can both bake and serve in them. If you remember to grease these baking dishes well, the washing problem is a simple one. If you forget, some washing soda will be a big help when it comes to washing these pieces.

COPPER WILL CLEAN Don't worry about keeping copper in its pristine glory. A paste of equal parts of salt, vinegar and flour will do the cleaning for you easily. Commercial cleaning powders for copper are also available.

CLUB AND CAST ALUMINUM The heavier members of the aluminum family fill a special usefulness when you want to do waterless vegetable cooking. Be sure to get self-heating lids though. These heavier aluminum are also fine in Dutch ovens.

ALWAYS SIFT WHITE FLOUR once before measuring on a sheet of waxed paper. Flour will be light and uniform even for each cupful. No guesswork!

TO KEEP CANDLES FIRM in candlesticks, melt paraffin, put it into the sockets, and while it is still hot, set the candles in.

NOVELTIES IN THE MENU

An Apple Pie with a foreign flavor is the same dear dessert as ever. Add a little orange marmalade and chopped crystallized ginger pudding.

Slice banana, and cut crosswise in slices to dress up bread pudding. Slice banana, run the prongs of a fork lengthwise down a peeled banana, then slice crosswise. Vegetable sauce may be dressed up by doing the same thing with peeled cucumbers.

If you are in too much of a hurry to roll bread or croquette crumbs for a ham loaf or hamburger patties, add rolled oats instead. You'll love the flavor.

Breakfast: Parboil 1/2-inch circles of thin orange rind for 12 minutes. Place in buttered frying pan. Break eggs into orange bands trying over low flame.

Broiling—Broil thick slices of apple which have been brushed with melted butter. Cover with slices of cooked sweet potato. Cut a strip of bacon in half and top sweet potato making a cross over all. Place under broiler until bacon is sufficiently browned.

Mix chopped Brazil nuts with cream cheese, stuff celery with the mixture and dip each stalk in additional finely chopped Brazil nuts. Add a few drops of lemon juice to rice the next time you cook it. It will keep the grain whole and make it beautifully white.

For a children's party try serving a marshmallow on a graham cracker that have been toasted in the oven together.

A little ginger added to chocolate icing to be used on a chocolate cake gives a delicious, unusual flavor. Use only a pinch of ginger.

Honeydew melon balls marinated in maple syrup make a delicious fruit cup for either a first course or dessert.

Add a grilling of nutmeg to chicken soup just before serving to give a delightful variation.

Stuffed potatoes with that certain something? Beat up the potato masher with hot cream, chopped cooked sausages and bits of crisp fried bacon. Add seasonings, stuff the baked shell, brown and reheat in oven or broiler.

Put a piece of thin chocolate candy bar and bonfire toasted marshmallows between two graham crackers in sandwich fashion.

Questions and Answers

Q What can I do to keep the bottom edge of a screen door from dragging on the threshold? The joints have become loosened so that the lower half of the door sags.

A A normal roll equipped with a tubular core may be fastened to the bottom rail clear of the door. One end of the rod should be fastened to the face of the door at the outer bottom corner, the other end as high up on the face of the vertical rail carrying the hinges as it will reach. When the two ends of the rod have been screwed on firmly, the turnbuckle may be turned clockwise to raise the door, or counter-clockwise to lower it. The bottom rail, if the screen door is in very bad condition, it will be more satisfactory to purchase a new door.

Q In building a new garage where should it be located?

A The garage should be located to provide easy access from street or alley as well as from the house itself. The attached or built-in garage offers added convenience and permits the saving of open areas for other purposes. Whether attached or detached, the garage should be so related to the house in design and location as to form a pleasing part of a grouping of buildings.

Q Does the shape of a house affect its cost?

A The square is the most economical shape since it provides the maximum of floor area with the least amount of wall area. Corner construction costs more than straight-wall construction with the result that square and rectangular-shaped plans are less costly than L, U or Z shapes. The square or rectangular shape usually simplifies the structural framing system of both floor and roof. It is thus more economical to erect.

Q Where is the most convenient location for living-room electrical outlets used for portable lamps?

A Suggesting the most convenient location for electrical outlets is difficult unless the contemplated furniture arrangements and available wall spaces are known. In general, it is preferable for outlets to be distributed through the room so that each lamp in its desired position will not be more than 6 feet from an outlet.

Usually, outlets located in the center of wall spaces are the most serviceable. However, when it is known that large pieces of furniture, such as sofas and chests of drawers, are to be placed in the center of wall spaces, it is desirable to locate the outlets to one or either side of the center. Outlets will then be accessible without moving the furniture.
