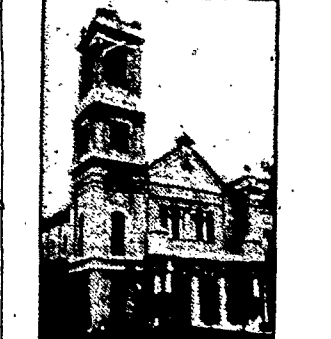

IF COUPLE SEPARATE

Q. If a couple separate and are not living together, can they receive the Sacraments?
A. If a couple separate, they must have permission and there must be serious grounds for doing so. If the man made life so unbearable for the wife and she is blameless, she can certainly receive the Sacraments, but if the other party is to blame for the situation and he refuses to rectify matters, he cannot receive forgiveness, because he continues in his wrong-doing. The same would apply to the woman if she is responsible.
