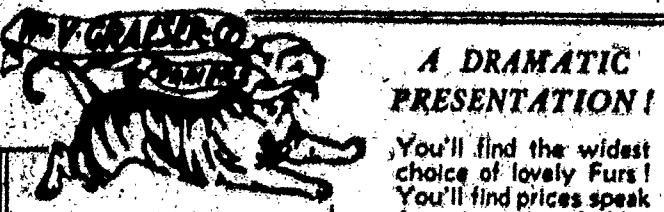
'Ave Maria Hour' To Reenact Discovery of True Cross

Washington Letter Post War Thoughts Occupy Spot Light For Today

WASHINGTON.—Fresh indications that Government leaders are thinking more and more of the past the United States is to play in the post-war world have been available in recent days.

Not the least of these, of course, came in the dramatically presented official announcement that President Franklin D. Roosevelt and Prime Minister Winston Churchill of England had met in conference somewhere at sea.

They point out that when commentators speak of the President Roosevelt and Mr. Churchill as their "joint war aims," it should be borne in mind that what is really meant is that these are the conditions both leaders want to see obtain after the present strife.

Addressing an appeal to the farmers of the nation to produce abundant crops, the President said "we need not only abundant production for ourselves and for other nations resisting aggression"...

NEW YORK—Sane consideration of our attitude toward the war in Europe, on moral, political, economic and military grounds, was urged by the Rev. Dr. John F. Cronin, S.S., Professor of Economics at St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore last Sunday night in the first of a series of three addresses on "Freedom Defended," which he is giving on the "Catholic Hour."
