Nazis Loot Lithuania, Carry On Red Outrages, **U. S. Group Charges**

Against this and the "brutai German treatment" and the brutal German treatment of other Baltic countries which un-til now were neutral in the war, the Federation in its letter ex-presses indignation, stating that at denies the Medical Country Country desires the United States Govern-ment "should hear of and know of the wrongs inflicted upon Lithu-ania and its liberty by the warring dictators." The letter recalls the establish-ment of a new independent Lithuanian Government after its successful revolt last June and how the Germans, following their murch into Lithuania in the Russo-German war, smothered the new Government and abolished its independence. "For twelve months the Russians

plundered the Baltic states, prepar-ing the field for the Germans," says the statement. "They hastened to confiscate all farms larger than 70 acres in area, all of the better buildings, printing presses; bank deposits, and home furnishings, to burn patriotic books, and to liqui-date the intelligentish." "The in-vading Germans, confirmed the Russian configurations and are not returning to the Lithuanians most of their farms, their homes and some of their factories. The Germans are seizing these properties as loot of war, which will aid them
