

Nazis Grab 74 Abbeys, Seminaries

Seventy-five abbeys, seminaries, convents houses of study and other establishments have been wrenched from the possession of Catholic religious by the Nazis in, Germany and in former Austria, it is revealed by documentary evidence that have realight the United States. that has reached the United States. that has reached the United States. About a third of the confiscations listed in threse documents took place in Germany proper, and the remainder in what formerly was Austria. Expulsion of Religious

The universal result of the confiscation of the properties seems to have been the expulsion of the prices. Brothers and Sisters from the particular locality in which their abboys or convents were lo-cated and where they had carried on their religious charitable and educational labors

Where churches were connected with the religious institutions they were closed. Schools attached to the institutions select were taken over for operation under the State

In at least some instances the confiscation of religious property was accompanied by violence on the part of the Nazi invaders. In the part of the Nazi invaders. In the seizure—of the Jesure novitiate at Mittelsteine, two lay Brothers were knocked down and a third Brother was sent to a concentration camp for three months. 
