Saint of 'Boyology'

The Saint of "Boyology" started his work under sad circumstances. His father died when John was only two leaving a very poor mother to support three sons. John worked as a shepherd and had to postpone his vocation for years. As a young priest, he accompanied a holy elderly priest on his visits to the prisons in Turin, Italy. There he saw many children in danger of learning worse evils. He resolved to devote his life to rescue these outcasts.

On December 8, when the saint drove away a ragged lad who refused to serve Mass, Father Bosco recalled the boy, became his friend and gradually drew other neglected children around him. He taught them religion and encouraged them to a better life. Many people criticized and opposed his efforts, thinking these boys not worth the trouble but Father Bosco persevered, got fifty priests and teachers to help him and started a religious Society under the patronage of St. Francis de Sales. Father Bosco was extraordinarily clever at amusing and winning boys, tireless in leading them by gentleness to goodness and God. He died honored by Popes and Statesmen, and his society now numbers seven hundred houses caring for thousands of young men.

HODGE, LA.—A school that has only a kindergarten and a music department was dedicated by the Most Rev. Daniel F. Desmond, Bishop of Alexandria, on the grounds of St. Henry's Church. Another missionary wrote to say that the only quinine in the district was that which was sent by the Catholic Medical Mission Board. The charitable feeling caused by war conditions seem to

have stimulated the gifts of medicines, instruments, bandages and dressings in favor of the medical missions. Many missions which have heretofore received medical supplies from Europe are now getting them from the Catholic Medical Mission Board.
