**Fr. Simeon's Father Dies At Age Of 82**  
Word of the death of Lawrence Kaczmarek in Shamokin, Pa. brought sorrow to his son, the Rev. Simeon Kaczmarek, O.M.C., pastor of St. Theresa of the Child Jesus Church, Rochester, on Monday Nov. 17, 1941.  
Death came to Mr. Kaczmarek at the age of 82 years. He was highly esteemed in his community and was the father of 12 children, six of whom entered religious orders. Three sons are ordained Franciscan priests and three of the daughters entered the Felician Sisters community.  
Mr. Kaczmarek was born July 18, 1859 in Posen district, Poland and came to America at an early age. He was married to Frances Fronkowska who died March 21, 1928.  
The eldest son the Rev. Giles Kaczmarek is Penitentiarius Apostolicus at St. Peter's, Rome. He is in America at present serving as temporary pastor at Sharon, Pa., having been ordered as an American citizen by the consul, to return because of the war.  
Besides Father Simeon, pastor of St. Theresa's, the other son in the Franciscan order is the Rev. Anacleto Kaczmarek who is Novice Master of Franciscan Novices at Elliott City, Mo.  
Sister Amelia, a daughter who was in the Felician community died in Dec. 1931. The other two nuns, Sister Victoria and Sister Consuela are both located at the Felician Sisters convent Jersey City.  
Another son Anthony resides in Rochester and Stanley lives in Shamokin. Pa. Helen has been a school teacher in Shamokin public schools for many years. Katherine took care of duties at home. Both were with the beloved father at death. All children were most attentive to their father during his lifetime.  
His priest-sons will officiate at solemn funeral services for Mr. Kaczmarek in St. Stanislaus Church, Shamokin at 10 a. m. Thursday Nov. 20, 1941.

Surviving Sister Celina are one brother, Frank Murphy of Canandaigua and three sisters: Miss Rose Murphy of East Cleveland, Ohio, Miss Josephine Murphy and Mrs. George Esterheld both of Rochester.
