FR. KELLEY GIVES OPENING PRAYER IN U. S. CONGRESS

WASHINGTON: The Rev. William J. Kelley, C.M.I., of Holy Angels' Church, Buffalo, N. Y., and a leader in social action movements, offered the prayer with which the session of the House of Representatives was opened Nov. 25.

Father Kelley is Director of Education of the New York State Joint Legislative Committee on Labor and Industry and since 1937 has been Chaplain of the Buffalo Federation of Labor. This year, in cooperation with the Grey Nuns of D'Youville College, Buffalo, he is directing the Cooperative Institute at that institution.
