QUEST

It was missionary and brave of the Boston Symphony to come all the perilous way from the besieged Atlantic to play so rare a work as the Symphony Pathétique of Tchaikowsky in our pagan town. This performance served, moreover, as a public rehearsal for the appearance of the Eastman School Symphony Orchestra in the Symphony Pathétique next Monday evening. The radio and juke box monopoly on Tchaikowsky shall not go unchallenged. The Pathétique shall be played until the last pagan is saved, and everyone sheds tears to the temple of the Russian eclectic.

Now, when our own sons are slain overseas, is no time to slacken our souls on spent music. Now is the time to tighten with Beethoven until we are resonant as drums, on the march for the peace of justice. Let the pulsant Athenians promote, not indulge, the public taste. Let this gem of American democracy, the gallant Boston Symphony under an inspired Koussevitzky, fly not furl, their banners when they come to Rochester. Now is no time to pauper. Now is the time for poetry of action.

Koussevitzky, to his honor due to the allegro tempo of the day, substituted music of Musorgsky for Ravel after Roosevelt's sounded war Musorgsky sang, and the people of the field, with hoes in their hands, and the look of winter trees in their eyes, took battle stanzas Musorgsky sang, and trumpets at the gate of Kiev rang to the marrow of heroism.

It remains to record beauty of performance in The Sea of Debussey.

Item. The program of the Philharmonic Orchestra under Jose Iturbi, with Alexander Kipnis, Thursday evening, Dec. 4, was artistically promising. Kipnis gave no encores. He sang four unfamiliar songs of Brahms: the lowest note he sang was G-sharp. He musically characterized the arias, Il lacerato spirito, from Simon Boccanegra, and Ella giammai m'amo, from Don Carlos by Giuseppe Verdi. The violoncelli, enamored of the music, sang alike.

Iturbi gave the first performance of The Song of the Nightingale by Bernard Rogers. The composer has made the bird an intellectual missionary in music of uncommon beauties. The day is not distant when he will come into his own as the musical Schubert of the times. What is to be said of orchestrations of Bach? Should Bach be orchestrated at all? These questions, like questions of human destiny, are unanswerable. If the orchestrator is Berlioz, questions would not come up. If the orchestrator is Leo Weiner, whose orchestration of

Iturbi gave an accurate, if incomplete, reading of the Unfinished Symphony. How naive and sincere is the music of Schubert! Not Schubert, but Schubert is the successor of Beethoven.
