Inter-Faith Group Cites Duties 'In Common Cause'

"Patriotic devotion to a common cause" is called forth from Catholic, Protestant and Jew, pacifist and interventionist in a statement released this week by the Inter-Faith Good Will Committee. Responsibilities and duties of religious people in the present national emergency are set forth.

Signers include the Rt. Rev. Msgr. William M. Hart, Vicar General of the Diocese of Rochester, chairman; the Rev. Hugh Chamberlain Barr, DD, executive secretary of the Federation of Churches of Rochester and Monroe County; Rabbi Philip S. Bernstein of Temple Beth Kodesh. Also as signers are James P. B. Duffy, Jacob Hollander, William MacFarlane, the Rev. Leo C. Mooney, the Rev. Justin W. Nixon, DD, William F. Nolan, the Rev. Paul M. Schroeder, DD, Joseph E. Silverstein and Henry M. Stern.

The statement pleads that Americans must not forget that among the most loyal citizens are those whose relatives live in the governments with which the United States is at war. It adds that we should assume the loyalty of every American regardless of the country from which he or his ancestors came.
