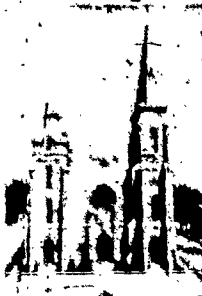

### Fr. Baker's Homes Offer Services To President For War Orphans

LACKAWANNA, N. Y.—The facilities of Our Lady of Victory Institutions here also known as Father Baker's Homes of Charity, have been offered "unreservedly" to the children of American soldiers killed in this war, in a letter addressed to President Roosevelt by the Rev. Joseph E. McGuire, Superintendent.

Father McGuire also offered to care for destitute or near-destitute adult dependents of soldiers killed in battle, although the institutions have been devoted to the care of children only in the past.

"We believe it obligatory on every American citizen and institution," Father McGuire wrote, "to do everything possible to give those doing the actual fighting the greatest mental freedom possible. We believe a soldier will be a better soldier will help us the sooner to forge a total victory over the forces of darkness, knowing that if the enemy does remove him from the field of battle, his loved ones will be taken care of."

Stating that the offer "applies to destitute dependents of any American soldier regardless of race, creed or color," Father McGuire said the Homes, with certain changes, could accommodate more than 1,000 additional children and a like number of adults.

### Salesians, in Northern Africa 50 Years, Have Many Flourishing Works

ORAN, Algeria. Fifty years have passed since the spiritual sons of St. John Bosco, the Salesian Fathers, landed here for the first time in 1891 and began their work in Northern Africa.

Since that day they have multiplied their numbers and their activities very nearly everywhere in the three dioceses of Algeria. One of their most impressive establishments is the boys' foundation in Oran known as *Giuliva Unione*, or *Joyous Union*, which was the name given by St. John Bosco himself to his first groups of boys.

The club has an active sports association and a *schola cantorum* that forms the choir for all solemn functions in the Oran Cathedral. The boys are trained in active practice of their faith and at the several Masses in the chapel each Sunday almost every member receives Holy Communion.

The Salesian Fathers also have an active parish at Casablanca, in Morocco. An index of their work is the fact that six boys of the foundation there are to enter the minor seminary this year.
