"I Thirst"
 The Redeemer's heartrending cry "I thirst" finds an echo in the soul of Father R. Bossi, missionary in Lolkaw, Burma, whenever he thinks of his first visit to the village of Tarudda. Perched on the very height of a summit the village could only be reached by climbing a path so steep it looked like a staircase, and surrounded by ravines into which one always ran the risk of falling. However, Tarudda housed souls for whom the Master thirsted and Father Bossi undertook the trip to win those souls.

This good missionary encountered the physical thirst as well as the spiritual on this trip. Water, always a problem in Burma, seemed to be non-existent on the memorable trip, and, despite the most careful preparations, the water bags were empty. Only the kindly interest of the natives of Tarudda saved the priest and his porters, since they were forced to spend the night without a single drop of water, even though the thermometer registered 110 degrees. Sometimes it would be a good thing to remember that warm night in Tarudda while the January winds and rain sweep over us here in America.

The World's Best Boatmen
 It remained for the Rev. H. Delmasco, Salesian missionary from China, to give us a pen picture of the men whom he considers "the best boatmen in the world the extraordinary Chinese who pull barges."

"The rivers in China," stated Father Delmasco, "are the greatest riches that Providence has given this country. They are great rivers, slow and crowded with innumerable barges and junks which go up and down delivering and collecting from huge steamers and tiny hamlets. For centuries these Chinese junks have been plying the rivers by the force of man-power only. Six or 10 men, bent and tied to a strong rope, propel them along the pathless river bank. Frequently the bargemen have to bend almost to the ground in their efforts, or again they may have to wade waist-deep in the water to insure the steady progress of the junk."

"For this arduous work they receive the magnificent pay of twenty American cents a day, together with a handful of rice, a few vegetables and dried fish. However, accustomed to hard work, little pay and a small amount of food, they can outdo European or American laborers."

An Important Duty
 It is impossible to overemphasize the fact that missionary activity is an essentially practical carrying out of a divine command. Too many Catholics, although they may agree that the undertaking is more or less a necessary one, fail to realize that it is one of the most important features of the work of the Church. Moreover, they sometimes do not appreciate the specific duty they have to assist in the Propagation of the Faith.
