45 Citizenship-Education Classes

Forty-five free Citizenship-Education classes known as "Americanization for Defense" classes are now available to all Rochester and vicinity aliens.

Financed by Work Projects Administration as part of a nationwide Americanization program of the United States Department of Justice, new classes and new centers will be formed until every eligible alien in the United States has the opportunity of learning American Government and to read, write and speak our language.

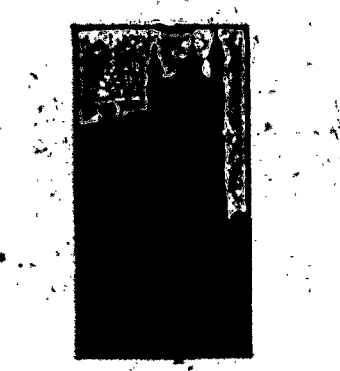

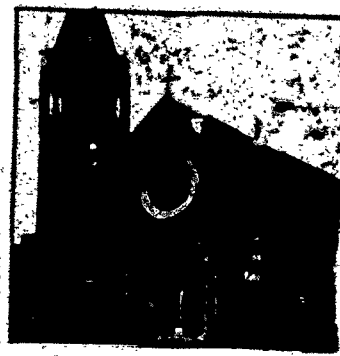

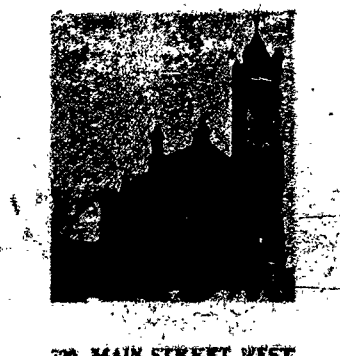
