Water Softener Is Helpful For Plumbing Systems

By preventing the formation of scale on the inside of water heater coils, water softeners aid in the conservation of copper which is near the top of the list of vital war materials, FFA officials point out.

Hard water is so-called because of its high mineral content. These minerals, consisting largely of lime and magnesia, are deposited on the inside of coils and pipe, particularly those carrying hot water.

Eventually the deposits of scale become so thick as to interfere with the flow of water. Because removal of the scale is a troublesome and expensive process, it has been customary to replace the coils.

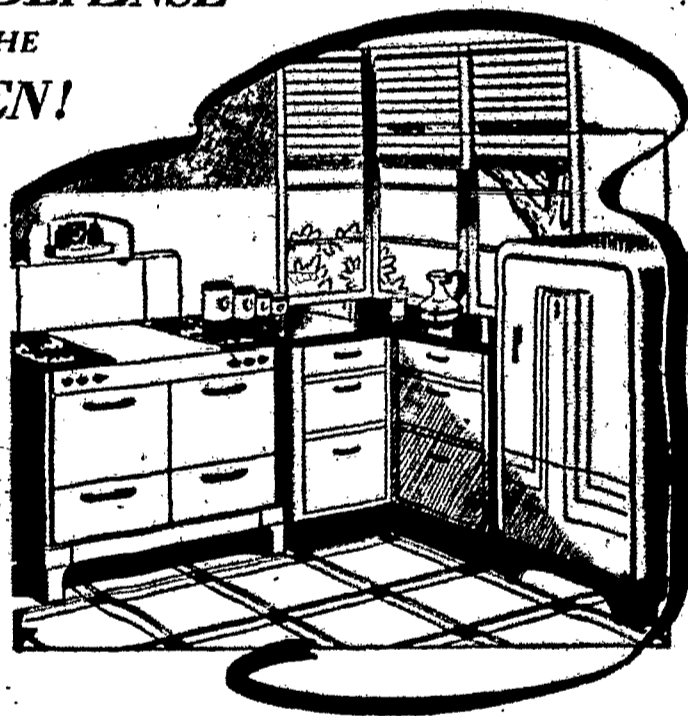
