Students Urge Dealers To Ban Evil Magazines

PITTSBURGH. — As a further step in its campaign against indecent magazines, the Catholic Federation of High School Students here, representing 10,000 members, is sending letters to dealers handling such publications, asking them to sign a pledge that they will discontinue the sale of the indecent reading matter.

On the strength of a survey which the Federation conducted, showing that 92 per cent of 400 stores sold indecent material classified as indecent, the organization is making the dealers an American citizen and parents to join with other dealers and refuse to sell a list of magazines appended to the letter and declared offensive by the National Organization for Decent Literature.

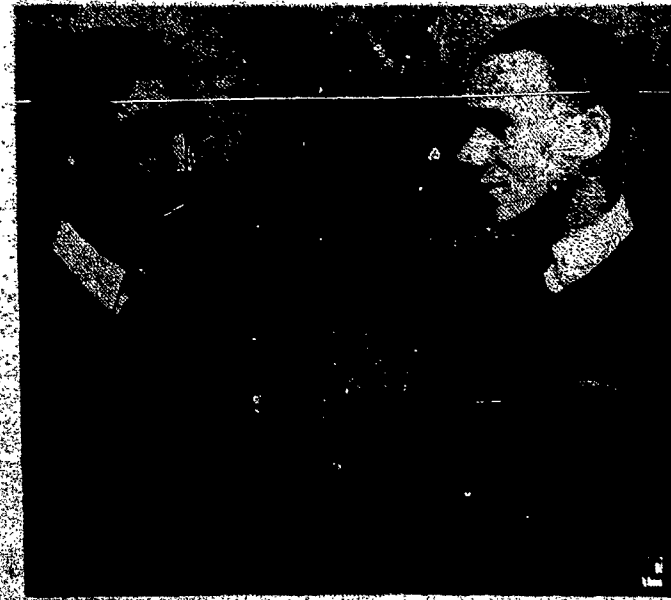
