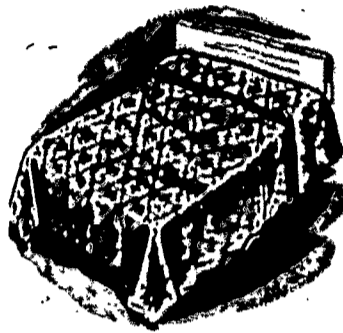
**Bequeaths Burse**
