## LIST LENTEN SERMON

The Rev. Donald M. Cleary, counsellor to Catholic students at Cornell University, will preach next Wednesday evening at St. Patrick's Church on the topic "Calvary, the Doctor and the Lawyer."

Father Cleary's impressive sermons have attracted a large attendance at the Wednesday evening services. The theme of the Lenten series is "The Return from Calvary." Prior to his sermons he

gives a brief instruction on some point of Catholic doctrine and practice.

This week's topic was "Calvary, Capitalism and Labor." For the final two sermons his topics will be: Mar. 18 "Calvary and the Teachers"; Mar. 25—"Calvary and the Home."

Next Sunday, Mar. 8, will be the regular Communion Sunday for members of the Holy Name Society. The members will receive at the 7:30 a. m. Mass.

## St. Patrick, Mo. Parish Possesses Articles From Noted Erin Shrine

ST. PATRICK, Mo. — An altar stone from Croagh Patrick, a chalice from Lough Derg, and a relic of St. Patrick obtained in Rome are among the possessions of the local parish, where the pastor, the Rev. Francis O'Duignan, plans the erection of a permanent shrine in honor of the Apostle of Ireland in this town which bears his name.

The shrine, which Father O'Duignan sees as replacing the present frame St. Patrick's Church, would be national in character and would belong to all "the scattered children of the Gael."

Croagh Patrick is a mountain looking out on the Atlantic Ocean from the southern shore of Clew Bay in County Mayo, and is called

"the Sinai of Ireland." Here, tradition says, St. Patrick spent the days of Lent in the year 441 in prayer and fasting. Pilgrims do penance on this mountain, a practice which, historians say, dates from the days of the Saint himself.

Lough Derg, in the Diocese of Clogher, is known as St. Patrick's Purgatory and has been a place of pilgrimage almost uninterruptedly for 1,000 years.

## ENGLISH CATHOLICS PLAN 'BIBLE SUNDAY'

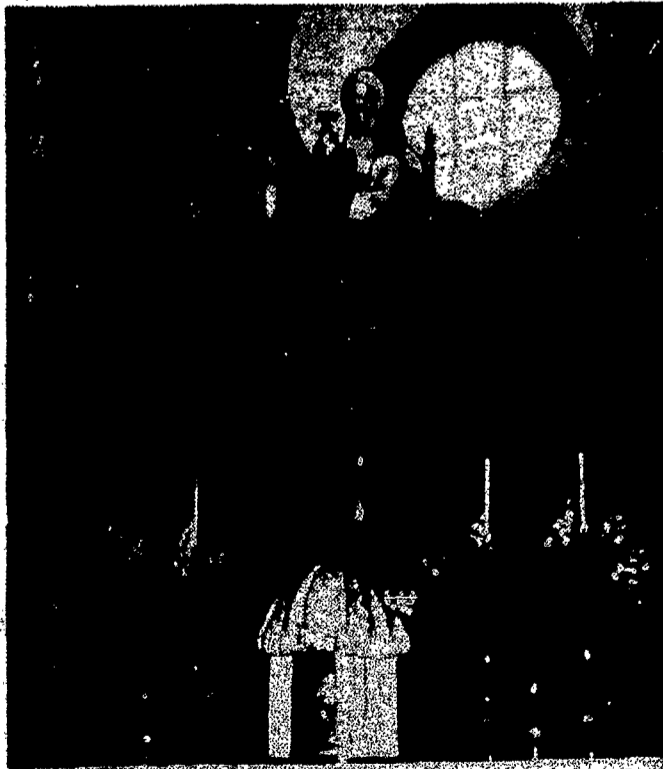
WASHINGTON.—Information of a movement to establish the annual observance of Biblical Sunday in Great Britain, as has been done in this country, is contained in a letter received from the Rev. C. Lattey, S.J., of Heythrop College, Chipping Norton, Oxon, England.

Father Lattey wrote to the Most Rev. Edwin V. O'Hara, Bishop of Kansas City and Chairman of the Episcopal Committee of the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, asking guidance in the movement and information concerning the observance in the United States.

Bishop O'Hara's reply told how Septuagesima Sunday has been established here as Biblical Sunday. "The celebration will be annual and the Catholic Biblical Association will join with the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine in promoting its observance," the Bishop wrote.

## REPLICA OF FAMED ENGLISH SHRINE



Believed the only one of its kind in a Catholic church in America, is the recently dedicated Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, in St. Bede's Church, in the Colonial capital of Williamsburg, Va. The statue, erected over the altar, is an exact wood carving in medieval design of the image of Our Lady of England and the eleventh century seal of the Priory of Walsingham.
