## Increased Demands of Rochester War Industries Keep the G and E Twins Stepping

If there is one thing we have always prided ourselves upon it is the efficiency of our service to our customers. We intend to keep this service at as high a standard as changed conditions will permit. However, like every other company, our manpower has been hit by the war. We have more than fifty employes in the armed forces of the United States and this has required some adjustments. All of this means that at times we cannot do all the things we'd like to do for our customers . . . at at least we can't do them as quickly. Here are a few suggested ways in which you can co-operate:

- Meter Installations**  
Please give us at least twenty-four hours notice on all installations of electric or gas meters. Make every effort to avoid asking for installations on Saturday.
- Turn-Ons and Shut-Offs**  
Please give us at least 24 hours notice within the city and villages and 3 days notice in sparsely settled areas for turning on or discontinuing gas or electric service.
- Moving Days**  
When you move from one residence to another please let us know in advance as far as possible, so that we may have everything ready for you. Tell us where we can get the keys and make certain that our representative can get to the meters and gas appliances when he calls.
- Keep Extra Fuses On Hand**  
Keep a few extra fuses on hand. Then you won't have to call us when one blows. This will save you money and inconvenience. It will also save the time of our service men for war work.
- Emergency Calls**  
We are always at your immediate service of course, in cases of real emergency. Just call Main 3960.
