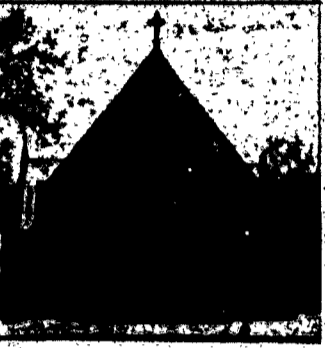

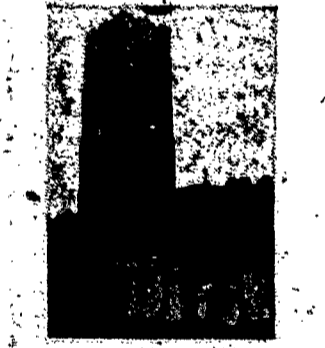

St. Bonaventure College Activities

ST. BONAVENTURE Six members of the St. Bonaventure College faculty will give retreats during Holy Week and Easter Week at widely separated places, the Very Rev. Celsus Wheeler, O.F.M., Guardian of the Franciscan Friary at the college announced this week.

The Rev. Fidelis O'Rourke, O.F.M., Dean of Commerce and acting treasurer of the College will give the Holy Week Retreat for students of St. Elizabeth's Academy, Allegany.

Others who will give retreats during Easter Week are: The Rev. Victor Mills, O.F.M., at the Franciscan Convent, Mt. Vernon, N. Y.; the Rev. Arthur Brophy, O.F.M., at the Franciscan Convent, Winsted, Conn.; the Rev. Benedict Ballou, O.F.M., St. Anthony's Convent, New York City; the Rev. Callistus Smith, O.F.M., St. Elizabeth's Convent, Allegany, and the Rev. Eustace J. Smith, O.F.M., at St. Mary of the Angels Convent, Williamsville, N. Y.

The annual retreat for Catholic Students of St. Bonaventure College will be conducted from Sunday, March 29, through the morning of Wednesday, April 1, by the Rev. Benedict J. Dudley, O.F.M., director of Franciscan Missions.

During the same period a non-Catholic retreat will be conducted for students of the Protestant faith, in accordance with the custom of former years. All students will be required to be in attendance at one of the retreats.
