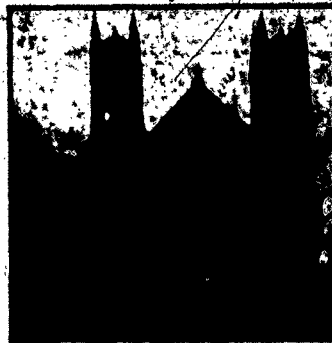

## Rites Set Today For John Burns

Funeral services for John Burns, highly-esteemed veteran newspaperman of Rochester will be held this morning, Thursday, March 26 from the home 206 Culver St. and at Blessed Sacrament Church.

Mr. Burns, 61, died Sunday night, March 22 following a heart attack while working on the copy desk of the Democrat and Chronicle. His son, the Rev. Richard K. Burns, assistant pastor of Holy Rosary Church, who will officiate at the funeral Mass, was summoned to the editorial rooms and administered the Sacrament of Extreme Unction. Mr. Burns died later at St. Mary's Hospital.

His death brought widespread sorrow especially among national and local leaders in sports. For many years he had been sports editor on daily newspapers and his kindly manner and willingness to assist others won for him a host of friends. Expressions of condolences received from all parts of the country from leaders in sports were added to the many from his friends in Rochester.

Mr. Burns is survived by his wife, Adelaide Knapp Burns; his son, Father Burns; one daughter, Mrs. David S. Grace; one sister, Mrs. Earl E. Baynes, and one granddaughter.

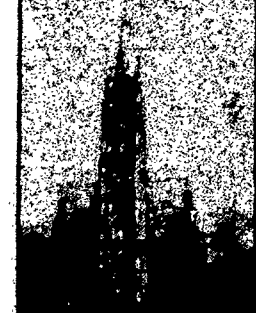
