EASTER SUNDAY

Masses on Easter Sunday will be the same time as on every Sunday: 8:45, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12:15. The 11 o'clock Mass will be a solemn High Mass. Rev. Dr. Maynard Connell of St. Bernard's Seminary will preach the Easter sermon at all the Masses.

The school children were dismissed last Wednesday noon for their Easter vacation and will return to school one week from Monday, on Apr. 13. During the vacation period there will be no classes in religious instruction for the boys and girls attending public schools. These classes—for high school and grammar school pupils—will be resumed on Apr. 13.

During Lent the hours of weekday Mass had been changed to make it more convenient for a greater number to assist at Mass and receive Holy Communion daily. However, after Easter, it has been thought advisable to return to the regular schedule of daily Masses. Beginning Monday, Apr. 6, the Masses each day will be at 6:45, 7:15 and 8:00 o'clock.
