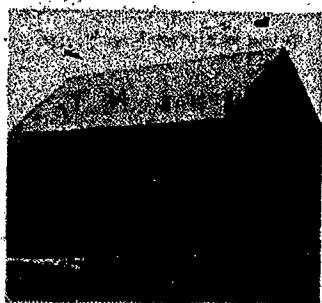
## Society Supper Apr. 7

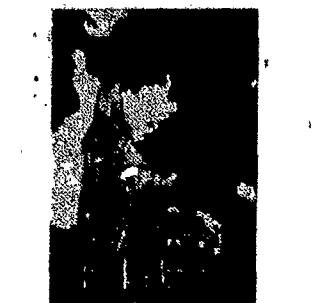

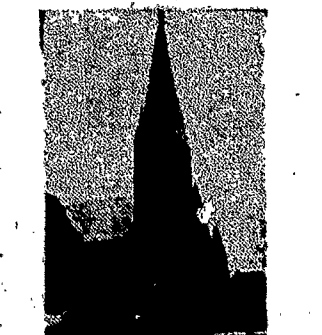

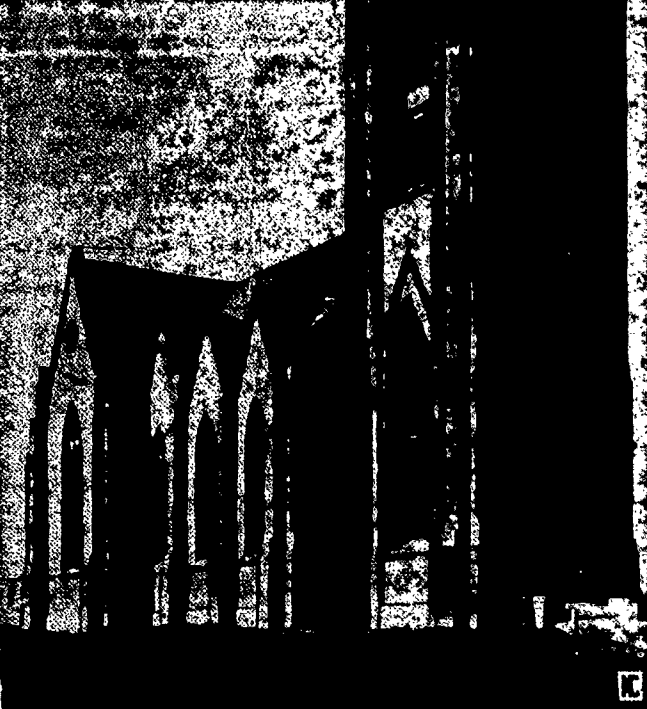

### HOLY PLACES STILL DRAW VENERATION OF PILGRIMS

Christian veneration of the places sanctified by the Passion and death of Our Lord began with the Church itself. In fact, the veneration of the Holy Sepulchre, had been so well established at the time of Emperor Hadrian that he decreed that this holy place in his effort to turn Christians into pagans.

One hundred and ninety years after Hadrian's act of profanation, St. Helena sought to restore, with honor, the place of Christ's Passion and Resurrection. She had only to remove the pagan terrace that Hadrian had caused to be erected, and the Sepulchre and Golgotha stood revealed. After the discovery of the Holy Places, Emperor Constantine entrusted Marcarius, Bishop of Jerusalem, with the building of a magnificent sanctuary on the very spot of the Resurrection.

### Served With Miners

London - The Rev. John Joseph McNally who had died in St. Helena, Lancashire, served in mining camps in the United States and in Sak Lake City. He was ordained in 1888. Father McNally also served as a missionary in South Africa.
