The flames bear inscriptions pertaining to Mary's sufferings. A large symbolic sword which pierces Mary's heart takes the place of the hand on an ordinary sundial. The rays of the sun shining on the dial and sword cast the sword's shadow, indicating the time of day. Fixed in the wall above this sundial is the following ancient Latin inscription:

"The Clock of the Mother of Sor rows indicating the last hours of life and the death of Christ."
