Final Rites Held For Sister of St. Joseph

Sister M. Irene Hines of the Sisters of St. Joseph died Tuesday, April 14, at Villa Marie, Wayland. Sister Irene was the sister of Mother Agnes Hines who was general superior of the Community for more than twenty-five years, preceding her death in May, 1921. Sister Irene, the daughter of the late John Hines and Regina Sadtler, was born in Churchville. She entered the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph in Rochester in 1876 and received the habit of the order in August, 1877. She taught successively in Danville, Auburn, where she opened St. Alphonsus Convent and School, Rochester, Ithaca and Elmira. Surviving are one sister, Mrs. Charles Holmes of Fairport; four nephews and four nieces. Funeral was held from Holy Family Chapel in Nazareth Convent (Pittsford) at nine o'clock Friday morning, April 17, 1942. Solemn Mass of Requiem was celebrated by the Rev. Albert Geiger, assisted by the Rev. Joseph Balcarak as Deacon and the Rev. William Naughton as Sub-deacon. The Rev. Lawrence B. Casey was Master of Ceremonies, the Rev. Edward K. Ball and the Rev. Gerald Lambert were Acolytes. Present in the Sanctuary were the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Joseph E. Grady, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Charles F. Shay, the Rev. Joseph H. Gefell, Rev. Louis Edelman, Rev. John B. Crowley, Rev. William Heisel and Rev. John M. Duffy. Final blessing was given by the Father Geiger. The blessing at the grave was given by the Rt. Rev. Msgr. William M. Hart, V.G., assisted by the Rev. Joseph H. Gefell. Interment was made in the Sisters' Plot in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

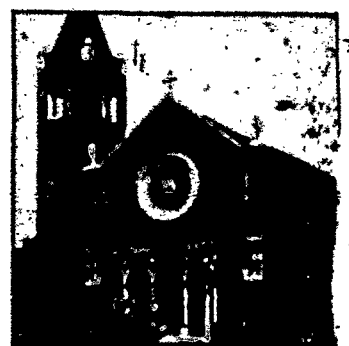
