**2 Pilgrimages To Shrine**

**BROOKLYN** - Bearing the approval of Bishop Thomas E. Molloy, two official pilgrimages to the Shrine of Ste. Anne de Beaupre, in Canada, will be conducted this summer under the auspices of the Catholic Travel League. It was announced last night. At the same time it was stated that Bishop Molloy has again appointed Rev. Dr. Reginald McKernan, pastor of the Shrine Church of St. Ann, Gold and Front Streets, Brooklyn, as the spiritual leader of the movements.

The dates for the pilgrimages are July 24 to 30, and August 10 to 16. This is the third year in succession that groups from Brooklyn, Queens and Long Island will travel to the most revered shrine in all of North America.

The first of the two pilgrimages will feature a visit to the Quebec shrine on July 28, the Feast Day of Ste. Anne; the second trip will feature attendance at Ste. Anne de Beaupre on Aug. 15, the Feast Day of the Assumption.
