Concern for Family

Realizing that the United States must win the war before it can begin to shape the peace, officials of the Government are nonetheless concerned about the pattern of American life in the days after the war. For example, even in discussing the possible induction of draft registrants who have dependents, instructions to local draft boards state: "The necessity of giving adequate consideration to the family unit where a child or children are involved cannot be over-emphasized and in such instances due consideration should be given to the family status, the maintenance of the home, and the desirability of continued paternal guidance and control. In the case of a registrant claiming dependents other than a wife, child, or children, the test to be applied is whether the alleged dependent comes within the definition of a dependent person and is financially dependent upon the registrant for support. The local board shall not, in classifying a registrant, consider the question of whether some other person, not morally or legally obligated to do so, could or would support the dependents of the registrant in the event of his induction."
