HOLY NAME GROUPS ASKED TO HOLD TRIDUUMS FOR JUBILEE OF HOLY FATHER

NEW YORK—National Headquarters of the Holy Name Society here has urged Spiritual Directors of parish Holy Name Societies throughout the country to arrange triduum under the society's auspices in commemoration of the Silver Episcopal Jubilee of His Holiness Pope Pius XII.

In a letter to the Spiritual Directors, the Rev. Harry C. Graham O.P., National Director of Holy Name Societies, suggests that the Triduum begin on Sunday, May 10, regular monthly Communion Sunday of the Society, and end on the following Wednesday, with as

many persons as possible in the parish receiving Holy Communion on the final day. Other suggestions made by Father Graham include a special brief sermon on the Life of Pope Pius XII each day and the

assistance at Mass and the reception of Holy Communion each morning for the intention of the Holy Father.

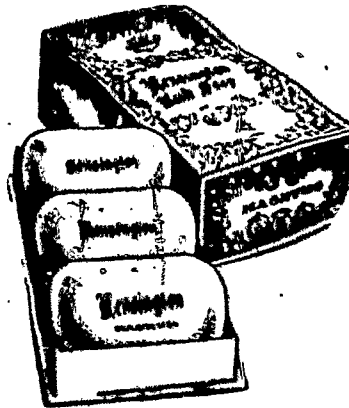
