# Catholic Gain In U.S., 263,141 In Year, 1942 Directory Reports

NEW YORK = (N. C.) -Catholics in the United States. Alaska and the Hawaiian Islands now number 22.556.262 according to the Official Catholic Directory for 1942, just issued by P. T. Kenedy & Sons here. With all of the Archdioreses and Discress. year showing aubstantial gains, this figure represents an in-crease of 263,141 over last year Archdioceses with Catholic populations in excess of one million are Chicago with 1.542.471 New York with 1.111,718 and Boston with 1. sontinues as the largest Diocese.

Three major changes are record. od in the geographical make-up of the Archdincesse and Diocesse in year's Directory: The Diocese of Denver was created an Archdiocase Nov 15 1941, and this new Prevince of Denver new embraces the Diocese of Cheyenro and the New Diocese of Pueblo, erected at the same time from part of the for-mer Diocese of Denvers The Videriate Apostolic of the Hawalian Islands became the Diorese of Monolulu on Sept. 10, 1941. The new Diocese of Pueblo comprises thirty counties of the State of Colsquere miles and his a Catholic population of 78,373.

The Archdioceses now number bwenty and there are 97 Dioceses.

In deference to the request of se United States Government, the Official Catholic Directory for the **Sect** time is publishing a large list of priests without addresses. These are the many hundreds of Ostholic clergymen now serving their country a Chaplains in the Military, Neval and Air Porces of the United States. In keeping with the policy not to disclose informa-tion of strategic value, Chaplains are this year listed according to their respective services only, in eare of headquarters at Washington, D C in which manner communications to members of the Chaptain Corps should be ad-dressed. The names of all Chaplains appear accordingly in the Military Ordinariate, pages 733 to 738, and also in the complete Alphabetical List of all, American Clergy, pages 917 1215. The total number of Chaplains and the numsee of those on active duty is in-creasing daily in keeping with the expansion of the Armed Forces. and no definite totals are available.

# Catholic Radio Activity **Expands Despite War**

COLUMBUS, Obio.—(NC)—Amid circumstances in which the Administrative Board of the National Catholic Welfare Conference declared "Christianity faces today its most serious crisis since the Church came out of the Catacomba," Catholic radio broadcasting on a national basis in the course of the past year was marked by a notable expansion of cristing artificial control of the addition of the catacombastic addition and the catacombastic addition of the catacombastic addition addit existing activities and the addition of new ones, the thirteenth Insti-tute for Education by Radio at Ohie State University here was told Monday.

Speaking at the session on Refron. This slight advance in the number of Catholic Churches is evidently due to the shortage of building materials and the departure of many priests as Chaplains with the Armed Forces.
