"One More To Watch Over Us"

An example of unheralded heroism of a kind unique in the outside world but not unusual in Makogai is told us by the Rev. Leo Lejeune, S.M., of the Leper Settlement in the Fiji Islands: "Here at Makogai we carry on as usual, but we do not know what the future has in store for us, as we live entirely on imported food and goods. However, we have here so many fine souls that Almighty God will always have an eye on us. Then we have all the Makogai Saints who are in the Kingdom of the Blessed and will surely protect those who have taken their places in this settlement.

"A particularly dear one among them all is a native Sister who left us six weeks ago. She was forty years in the religious life. When this place was established in 1911, she was chosen to accompany the two European Sisters who had been appointed to start the work. In 1924 she was found to have contracted leprosy and had to leave the Sisters' compound to come and live among the patients. She had been with them ever since for seventeen years. These last two years her health had been gradually falling and she could not do much, but her presence was an inspiration to them all, including some 200 women patients.

"When the end came she renewed her vows and made the sacrifice of her life as joyfully as she had carried her cross. She is one more to watch over us from Heaven, and one more, I am sure, to pray for our dear American friends."

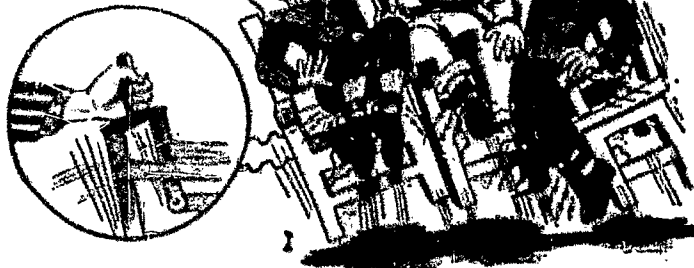

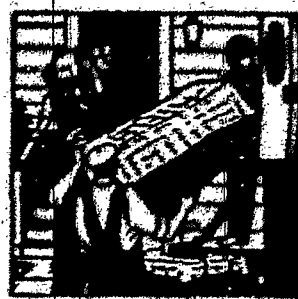

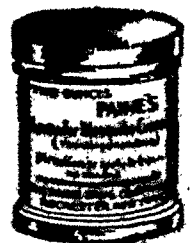
