spiritual prop by failing to show them the way to God.
How is it possible that a father can act that way? For anyone to question his loyalty to his children. and his love for them, would, in some osser, mean physical assauk. And still, where are his loyalty and his love when, by suspicious stub-tornness and kollow, idiotic rea-soning he refuses a chance for upright, wholesome, pure manhood to the helplessly floundering boy who

adores him? How is it that fathers can act so stupidly and heartlessly? How is it possible that some of these fathers, who are not ignorant, behave that way? Can it be that they do not want to be hypocrites? In this case, it would be more manly to be hypocrites than to be cowsouls.

Parenthood carries with it many and grave eternal obligations. But there is none more essential, none more vital, than good example. If that is lacking, all other efforts to raise good and decent children may be in sain.
