NEW YORK The newly inaugurated Catholic Cheirmasters Correspondency Course under the academic direction of St. Albertus College of Racine, Wisconsin, offors to the nation's thousands of organists and chairmasters an unprecedented opportunity to study all the branches of sacred music under accredited college supervision. This course will be a boon to those who have had no opportunity to attend college courses in sacred music.

The course consists of 110 text lessons covering such subjects as Liturgy, Liturgical Aesthetics, Latin Pronunciation, Elementary Chant Theory, Rhythm Chironomy Modality, Psalmody the Training of Children's and Boys' Choirs, Male Chair Training and Polyphony. A series of several albums of correlated recordings made by national groups correlates the theory of the text lessons.
