INSTRUCTION FOR AIR RAID PROTECTION

Soon we shall tie a tag marked "AIR RAID PROTECTION" to the gas pipe at the main valve in your home. Be sure you know where this tag is located. Follow instructions on this tag in the event of an air raid. These instructions are as follows:

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Keep clear space in front of main gas valve at all times so that you can get to it easily.
- 2 Keep a pipe wrench handy at all times.
- 3 IF BOMBS ARE FALLING CLOSE ENOUGH TO RATTLE WINDOWS VIOLENTLY or CAUSE YOU TO FEEL A DISTINCT JAR or IF GAS PRESSURE IS LOW

Shut Off Gas at the main valve marked by an "AIR RAID PROTECTION" tag tied to gas pipe!

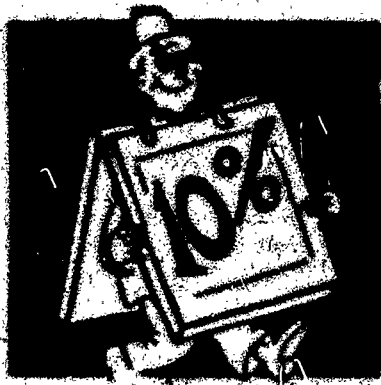
—WARNING— Do Not Turn On Gas!

In case the gas has been shut off, as outlined above, do not turn gas back on! **W-A-I-T**... for a member of the Rochester Gas and Electric Emergency Crew, who is working in your neighborhood. He will restore your service.

and down to our own days. You have but to run down a list of the names of the men who became prominent in that long-drawn-out battle to see the truth of this. The Healy and O'Brien and Sullivan of that period are graduates of the schools of the Christian Brothers; the O'Connell and Redmonds of the Jesuits, etc. And now we have an "Irish Nationalist"—who could find no place in Irish life worthy of his talents—declares that "The Teaching Religious Orders are the curse of Ireland."

To understand all this it is necessary to know something of the history of the "System of National Education," why it was at first denounced and finally accepted by the ecclesiastical authorities, also the change brought about by the foundation of the Free State when, under an Irish Government having full control of education, it can be called truly national. I cannot do this in the space at my disposal for this week. But I would ask the reader not to imagine that it is purely an Irish question which does not greatly interest him. For it is not. What Paul Vincent Carroll wants to do for Ireland is just exactly what the so-called "Liberals" of Spain did for that country from 1833 to 1936. We have all now seen the results.

RESULTS IN SPAIN
And what results! The Spanish "Liberals" first got rid of the Religious Orders, by suppression and confiscation. Next they secularized the schools. Then notwithstanding their boasting about enlightenment they never supplied schools or teachers for over half the children of the nation. From 1876 onwards the Religious Orders were allowed to return. They began to build up their schools again and in 1881—when the Monarchy fell they were educating just "one-half of all the children who were receiving any education at all in Spain." The quotation is from Madariaga's book "Spain" written in 1927; and Senor Madariaga is "Liberal" and anti-clerical enough not to be suspected of exaggerating in this matter.

Then when the Republic was established its leaders again closed the Catholic Schools maintained by the Religious Orders and suppressed these Orders. And they did this on the plea—which is the plea now of Paul Vincent Carroll—that the Religious Orders were incompetent as teachers and their curriculum out of date in this age of enlightenment. And just like Mr. Carroll, they knew they were lying. Senor Madariaga concedes this and objects to the Catholic Schools did not allow enough diversity of opinion in matters religious and philosophical! The same superiority of the Catholic schools was shown in the fact which was revealed in the Revolution of 1931-1933, that many of the men who led the Revolution and had voted for the suppression of the Catholic Schools had been sending their children to these same schools. It may seem a paradox, but the same thing happened in France. What is more and seems diabolical—both in France and Spain men sent their children to the Catholic Schools and after their graduation would not allow them to go to Church or to the Sacraments. What is more those men who ultimately brought ruin to France and Spain were eulogized in other countries and in our own. They assumed the name of "Democrats," or "Liberals," or "Republicans," while they were neither in any true sense, and that was sufficient for all Liberals and Progressives to eulogize them the world over.

In another article I will explain the Irish School System from its inception one hundred years ago up to our own days. This will help to show what Mr. Carroll and his likes are aiming at in their denunciation of "clerical control and management."

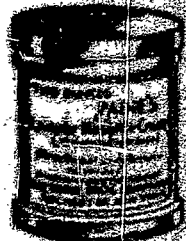
