Reich Bishop's Letter Protests Persecution

interrogations, concerning the carrying out of their ministry, or to be deprived, in spite of their absolute innocence, of their personal freedom in many instances for weeks—and, on top of all this, to see them excluded from their educational duties and even expelled from their native land.

Malicious Accusation

"If for this reason, as has already happened so often, false and malicious accusations should be made directly or indirectly against me for want of better and more honorable weapons, that shall not change my attitude. On the contrary! Facing condemnation, facing even execution, I, as a Catholic Bishop, shall remain without fear, for in me there resides the certitude that I am responsible for German Christians to the Supreme Judge, eternal and just, before Whom will appear also, some day, those who are attacking.

"As for myself, I have the firm conviction, which fills me with joy and courage, that I am rendering a most meritorious service to my beloved Fatherland whenever I use all the forces at my command to preserve for the German people, and this also for our non-Catholic Christian brothers, the Christian religious spirit, its principles, its rules.

"At the end of your letter Mr. Minister, you write that the soldiers at the front, and among them the members of the clergy who are with them, would not understand it if they were told that there are at home certain individuals who are traitors to the country they are exposing their lives to defend.

"I reply and I do this on the basis of irrefutable evidence, that the crimes against the nation have not been committed by me but by those who attack Christianity by those who have started this conflict, that at the front innumerable soldiers, famous generals and heroes who have covered themselves with glory (Moelders, von Weera, et al.) feel the deepest pain and are highly indignant when they learn that, in spite of the enormous sacrifices which they are making as Christian soldiers, their religious convictions and their Church are continually attacked at home and that the attackers get away without punishment. I am at your entire disposal in order to prove this assertion by documents in my possession."
