Sister Stephen Marie O'Hara

Funeral services were to be conducted today July 16, in Holy Family Chapel at Nazareth Convent for Sister Stephen Marie O'Hara of the Sisters of St. Joseph.

Sister Stephen Marie died Tuesday, July 14, in St. Mary's Hospital following a brief illness. She was born in Rochester, the daughter of the late Hugh O'Hara and Mary Healey and entered the order in 1913. For more than 25 years she has taught in the parochial schools of the diocese, including St. Mary's School, Canandaigua, Nativity School, Brockport, St. Mary's School, Auburn, and Cathedral Holy Rosary and Sacred Heart Schools in Rochester. Surviving her are three brothers, Charles and Stephen O'Hara of Rochester, and Maurice of Phoenix, Ariz., three sisters, Mrs. Thomas Cashman, Miss Lillian and Miss Laura O'Hara, all of Rochester.

Burial was in the Sisters' Plot at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

Named To Post At New La Salette Seminary

The Rev. Stanley Matuszewski, M.S., former Rochester orator who was recently ordained to the missionary priesthood, was appointed Prefect of Discipline at La Salette Calvary Seminary, Olivet, Illinois. The appointment was made by the Very Rev. Paul M. Regan, Provincial Superior of the La Salette Fathers, Hartford, Conn.

The new seminary, which until recently was a Protestant college, will train priests for post-war Europe. The huge educational plant was purchased at a cost of more than a half a million dollars. It will officially open next September.

Father Matuszewski is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Matuszewski, 29 Zygmunt St. His brother, Rev. Leo J. Matuszewski, is assistant pastor of St. Stanislaus Church.

UKRAINIAN CHAPLAIN
