

Priest-Pilot Rescues Civilians

LONDON. Many civilians who have been rescued from the war zone in New Guinea have Father John Glover priest-pilot and chaplain with the Australian forces, to thank for their safety. Father Glover has made repeated flights over Papua in this work, flying a tiny Spartan plane and risking attacks from Japanese fighters.

Word of the priest's activity has been brought to the people of Australia by two pilots who have returned there after working with Father Glover in ferrying hundreds of men, women and children from the interior of Papua to Port Moresby, according to The Catholic Times here. Father Glover's air exploits have

won him the title of the "Flying Father." A priest of the Diocese of Wexford, he was sent to Alexandria mission station of the Divine Word Fathers to assist them after some of the missionaries had been killed in a plane crash. He took up flying several years ago and is a licensed pilot.

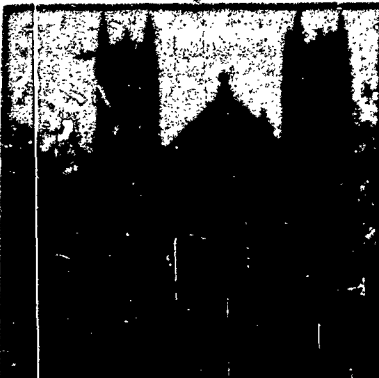

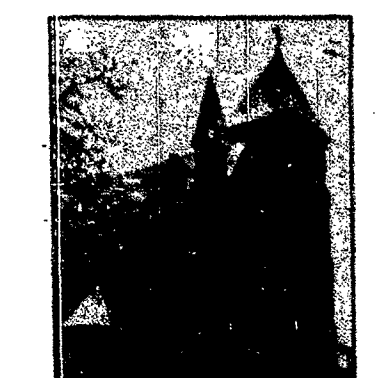
