Asks Child Welfare Plan Safeguard Faith, **School Affiliation**

ALBANY, N. Y (NC) -- Declaration that the New York State Catholic Welfare Committee is particularly interested in any program of the State War Council which deals with "the establishment and maintenance of so-called child care and development centers" was made in a letter sent to Governor. Harbert H. Lehman by C. J. Tobia, secretary of the welfare agency.

Listing the points that his or-ganization would like to emphasize in connection with any such pro-gram, Mr. Tobin mentioned first "that the child's religious faith and school affiliation be absolutely pro-

Existing schools institutions and ON AUG. 15 AND 16 URGED agencies, Mr. Tobin said, both poblic and private, should be used before any new center is established within a given locality. He also urged that "the care, protection and instruction of a child be explicitiy placed under existing health, welfare and educational agencies, public and private, rather than a new agency to be estab-lished."

The letter requested that in planning and establishing the rules and regulations governing the program there should be obtained the active participation of the State Charities id Association, the New York State Catholic Welfare Committee and

the Jewish Welfare Federation. The letter further requested that the program be set up on a wartime emergency basis in order that it can be definitely eliminated after the war.
