Nuns from This Diocese Aid Flood Victims

ST. BONAVENTURE, N. Y. — Following the traditional charity of the Franciscan Order, the priests of St. Bonaventure College gave their full assistance and turned over the facilities of the College to Olean and surrounding districts in helping to combat the effects of the worst flood in the history of Southwestern New York and Northwestern Pennsylvania. The entire personnel of the college played a prominent part in flood rescue operations.

Sisters attending summer school helped arrange beds in the classrooms and in the gymnasium. The Sisters included Sisters of St. Joseph from Erie, Pa., and Rochester. Sisters of St. Francis from Williamsville, N. Y., Stella Niagara, N. Y., and Peekskill, N. Y., Benedictine Sisters, Mercy Sisters from Rochester and Buffalo, Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary from Philadelphia, and Dominican Sisters from Newburgh, N. Y.

Among those who answered a call at 4 a. m. to help in evacuating families in Olean were 40 Franciscan clerics, 20 aviation cadets now stationed at the college, and 20 collegians as well as many of the priests.

The Very Rev. Celsus Wheeler, O.F.M., Guardian of the St. Bonaventure College Franciscan Priory, and Squadron Commander of the Olean Unit of the Civilian Air Patrol, was on continuous duty with the Air Patrol, and himself drove a truck loaded with food from the College to Portville Sunday.

In charge of the work were the Rev. Lambert Zalcha, O.F.M., Civilian Defense Coordinator for the St. Bonaventure College Unit, the Rev. Victor Mills, O.F.M., in charge of the Red Cross at the college, and Father Celsus.

Basilian Fathers Plan Novitiate Opening

(Continued from Page 1) tion into the Novitiate which marks the beginning of his year as a novice.

The new Novitiate will be established in a wing of the Basilian Fathers' residence situated to the west of Aquinas Institute and which was formerly Nazareth College.

Master of Novices will be the Rev. W. C. Sharpe, C.S.B., whose family home is in Port Huron, Mich., and who for many years has been pastor of Holy Rosary Church, Toronto. The Spiritual Director will be the Rev. J. McGuire, C.S.B., who was at one time on the faculty of Aquinas Institute.

It is expected that 17 or 18 novices will be accepted the first year. Father O'Loane stated they will come from Rochester, the Middle West and Texas where the Basilian Fathers have foundations.

The Basilian Fathers took charge of Aquinas Institute, Catholic high school for boys in 1937. In the June graduation of this year, 222 boys received their diplomas and the student enrollment has passed the 1,100 mark.

Youth Training The Congregation of St. Basil was founded in France in 1822 by a group of diocesan priests and has been devoted principally to the Christian training of youth. They came to Toronto (Canada) in 1892 to found St. Michael's College. In 1927 the Holy See established the community in America as a separate Congregation. The Congregation directs a number of educational institutions in Canada including St. Michael's College at Toronto, Assumption College at Windsor, St. Thomas More at Saskatoon and St. Mary's at Calgary. In the United States the Basilian foundations are in Rochester, Detroit and Houston, Texas.

The Basilian Fathers are also engaged actively in parish work and support a Mission Band which works among the Mexicans in southern Texas.

They have been promoters of the Christian Culture Lecture series which has become internationally known at Windsor, Ontario and Detroit. Last year, another series bringing famed authors, lecturers and educators was opened at Aquinas Institute with the Rev. Hugh J. Haffey, C.S.B., in charge. The success of the venture in Rochester during its first year assures its continuance and development.
