**Bishop Calls For All Out Effort In War**

very foundation of Christian principles, Christian teachings and the Christian way of life.

"And if we desire any confirmation of this analysis and appraisal we may consult the testimony of the hierarchy, clergy and religious of the Netherlands, and more especially of Cardinals Hertling, Schulte and Paphaber, of Germany. These faithful followers of Christ, these valiant spiritual leaders vehemently protest against the efforts to dechristianize their people and they fearlessly expose the totalitarian objective to destroy the traditional division of life in its separate secular and religious spheres.

"We know now, if we did not know sooner, that these subversive forces, directed by an unscrupulous political party and a ruthless military leadership, seek to gain control not only of the human body but also of the human soul. They are seeking to place all peoples in physical, intellectual and moral bondage. And they are striving not only to conquer Europe, Asia and Africa, but to dominate the world. If they succeed the results can only be universal chaos and slavery.

His Excellency extolled "the noble patriots who framed our Constitution," pointing out that to every American citizen has come the "blessed inheritance of civil, political and religious liberty safeguarded by the American Constitution.

"Such was the spirit in which the great democracy of America was born," the Bishop continued. "The spirit that honors manhood, the spirit that favors freedom and frowns on despotism, and any spirit other than this is not the spirit that stands behind the traditions and laws of this land.

"The mighty issues of this war as well as the technical nature of the war mean that we are all participants.

"Some of us are called to take our part in the armed forces, some of us are producing the materials of war in industry, some of us are concerned with the war economy, some of us are engaged in a war of ideas. All of us have some part in civilian defense, all of us are called upon to make sacrifices in our accustomed standard of living and to contribute an increasingly large share of our substance to our national war effort. Our American people have shown themselves willing to go far beyond what has been asked of them in sacrificing and contributing to the full prosecution of war.

**Have Large Share**

"There are, however, still a great many who have not yet fully realized what a serious crisis we face and how they might contribute to meeting that crisis. The appeal by radio and the press and public speakers to contribute to the war effort by purchasing War Bonds and Stamps has somehow not become a personal appeal to them. The talk of the dangers of inflation remains an academic subject which the nation's economists and financiers must attend to. They do not realize that they themselves have a large share in deciding how much of the country's labor and material will go into the munitions of war and how much will go into those goods which will gratify their personal wants.

"It is a time for talk not of rights but of responsibilities, of their duty to put forth that extra effort in working and saving both in self-interest and in the interest of our national destiny. We are all at war.

"After 450 years then, the example of Christopher Columbus, his faith, his indomitable will, his reckless courage in the face of danger, his self-sacrifice for his ideas, all these come to us today as an inspiration to preserve for posterity the treasures of human dignity and freedom.


"The words of Lincoln in another national crisis come to us with prophetic power. 'No person of significance or insignificance can spare one or another of us.' The fiery trials through which we pass will light us down in honor or dishonor to the latest generation. We shall nobly save or meanly lose the last great hope on earth.

"The tradition tells us that when Columbus had his little band set foot on this continent their first action was to drop to their knees in prayer to God. Their simple, silent benediction service made America God's Country. After 450 years, you and I pledge ourselves tonight, God help us, to keep it
