Across the Pacific—A-2

Humphrey Bogart, Mary Astor, Sydney Greenstreet and Director John Huston are the combination that made "The Maltese Falcon" one of the most striking melodramas that has ever been screened. The excitement is now limited for another fast-paced melodrama, a little more commonplace as to set-up but a generally creditable job for all parties concerned.

But the geographical confusion won't bother most audiences for very long. Director Huston keeps things moving too quickly for that. Bogart gives another of his best characterizations and Mary Astor is a charming heroine, who infuses her role with warm humor.

The War Against Mrs. Hadley—A-1

There is a short subject, "A Letter from Bataan," which is now being shown at most theaters. It is a very well-made movie, with a capable cast (Richard Arlen, Janet Beecher, Jimmy Lydon, Susan Hayward), acting a story about a family receiving a letter from their boy who was killed at Bataan because of insufficient supplies.

On the other hand, there is "The War Against Mrs. Hadley." This is a feature picture, produced by M-G-M and compared in its advertising to "Mrs. Miniver." But when "The War Against Mrs. Hadley" is all over, you have the impression that you have been looking at another of those pictures produced by the government to stimulate war morale.

It has to do with a Washington matron who has a horror of anything that will intrude upon the security of her own little world. When war comes, she fails to see how it will affect her. Then her son is drafted; her daughter, a canteen worker, meets and marries a young soldier; her lifelong admirer and her best friend are both alienated when their war work proves more important to them than does Mrs. Hadley's comfort.

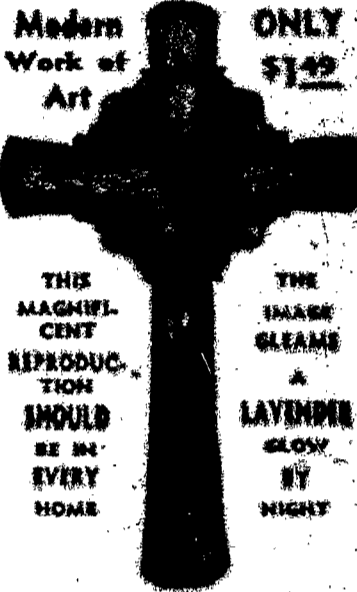
All of this has been very well acted by a cast that knows its business. The dominating role, of course, is that Mrs. Hadley and the always-admirable Fay Bainter.
