American priest reported slain was born at Lawrence, Mass Oct 19, 1909, and went out to the South Pacific Missions in 1929 The Rev. Henry Oude-Engberink, S.M. also reported slain was Father Duhamel's immediate superior. He was a native of the Netherlands. The iwo priests were known to have been stationed at Ruavatu, Guadalcanal, when the Japanese began their invasion of the Solomon Islands, and the mission station is believed here to have been the

Father Duhamel had written to Marists here that his mission "has the least number of conversions," was "the hardest to work in the whole Vicariate, and that our only hope is the bush, for other missions flourish in the more settled parts
