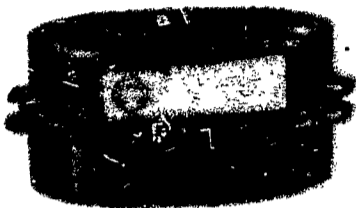

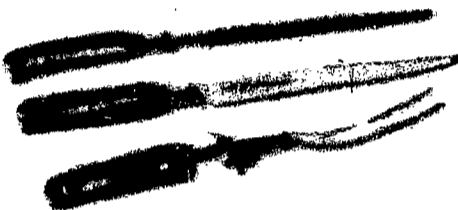

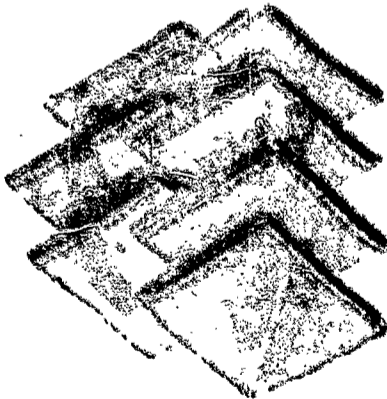

Most Rev. F. J. Monaghan

Bishop F. J. Monaghan, Ogdensburg Ordinary, Dies, Noted Educator

Watertown, N. Y. (NC) - The Most Rev. Francis J. Monaghan, fourth Bishop of Ogdensburg, died in Mercy Hospital here Nov. 13 at the age of 52.

His Excellency, the Most Rev. James E. Keane, D.D., Bishop of Rochester and the Rt. Rev. Mgr. William M. Hart, V.G. attended the funeral services on Wednesday, Nov. 18 with other high-ranking prelates of the province.

Bishop Monaghan, noted as a theologian, preacher and educator, suffered a cerebral hemorrhage following a heart attack last week. Late in September he received severe head and wrist injuries in a fall from a train and had been a patient in the hospital ever since.

Bishop Monaghan had spent 27 years in the priesthood. He was consecrated Titular Bishop of Meis and Coadjutor Bishop of Ogdensburg on June 29, 1938, and succeeded Bishop Joseph H. Conroy upon the latter's death March 20, 1939.

Born in Newark, N. J., October 30, 1890, Bishop Monaghan was graduated from Seton Hall College, South Orange, N. J., with high honors in 1911. He received his M.A. degree from Seton Hall two years later and went to Rome, where in 1915 he was graduated from the North American College and ordained.

Following his ordination Bishop Monaghan did parochial work in New Jersey until 1920, when he was appointed Professor of Pedagogy at Seton Hall and Professor of Dogmatic Theology and Metaphysics at the Immaculate Conception Seminary, then in South Orange. The institution is now in Darlington. He also taught ethics at St. Elizabeth's College, Convent Station, N. J., and Catechism in the advanced department of the Mount Carmel Guild Catechetical School in St. John's School, Paterson, N. J.

On May 20, 1934 His Holiness Pope Pius XI named Bishop Monaghan a Papal Chamberlain with the title of Very Reverend Monsignor.

In 1933, he was appointed Rector of Seton Hall College and Director of the Aquinas House of Studies on the campus, serving in that capacity until his elevation to the hierarchy three years later.

there can be no securely ordered world.

"Totalitarianism, whether Nazi, Communist or Fascist cannot write a real and lasting peace. The State that usurps total powers, by that very fact, becomes a despot to its own people and a menace to the family of nations.

"The Spirit of Christianity can write a real and lasting peace in justice and charity to all nations, even to those not Christian."

Asking "our people to be united and prepared to make every sacrifice which our Government deems necessary for a just and enduring peace through the victory of our armed forces," the Bishops add that "we are confident that they will perform their wartime duties gladly because they know that our country has been the defender, not the destroyer, of liberties."

Dutch Archbishop Bars Services On Nazi Radio

NEW YORK (NC) - Word has been received here by the Netherlands Information Bureau that the

Most Rev. John de Jongh, Archbishop of Utrecht, persisting in his stance against cooperation with the Nazis, has refused to allow church services to be broadcast over German-controlled radio stations. His stand was taken, it was said, on the grounds that these stations were being used to disseminate Nazi principles.
