Cleveland Coadjutor; Scranton Auxiliary Bishops Appointed

WASHINGTON, (NSC) — Announcement was made at the Apostolic Delegation Nov. 17 that His Holiness Pope Pius XII had transferred the Most Rev. Edward F. Hoban, Bishop of Rockford, to the Titular See of Lystra and appointed him Coadjutor Bishop with right of succession to the Most Rev. Archbishop Joseph Schrembs, Bishop of Cleveland, and had appointed the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Martin J. O'Connor, pastor of St. Joseph's Cathedral and Vicar General of the Diocese of Scranton, Titular Bishop of Thespia and Auxiliary to the Most Rev. William J. Hickey, Bishop of Scranton.

Appointed to the Hierarchy in 1923 and named Auxiliary Bishop of Chicago, Bishop Hoban was consecrated by the late Cardinal Mundelein on Dec. 21, 1921. He was transferred to the See of Rockford as its Ordinary on February 10, 1928.

Eucharistic Congress Figure

Bishop Hoban was Honorary President of the Twenty-eighth International Eucharistic Congress, held in Chicago in 1926, and in that capacity carried much of the responsibility for the success of that great demonstration of faith which attracted a million persons to Chicago.

In December, 1937, Bishop Hoban was named as Assistant of the Pontifical Throne by the Holy Father.

As Coadjutor Bishop of Cleveland, Bishop Hoban will share some of the great burdens and responsibilities of Archbishop Schrembs, who for more than 21 years has guided the destinies of a Diocese which now numbers more than half a million souls.

Bishop-elect O'Connor was born in Scranton on May 18, 1906 the son of the late Martin J. and Belinda (Caffrey) O'Connor. He was educated at St. Thomas College (now the University of Scranton), St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, and the North American College, Rome. He was ordained to the priesthood in the Basilica of St. John Lateran, Rome, March 13, 1924.

Bishop O'Connor also attended the Propaganda College and the Apollinare University in Rome, receiving the Doctorate in Theology from the former and the Doctorate of Canon Law from the latter. Held Many Diocesan Posts.

Returning to Scranton, he served as Secretary to the Bishop from Aug. 1, 1919, to Jan. 1, 1934; as Chancellor from Aug. 1, 1930, to Jan. 1, 1936; as Pro-Synodal Examiner from September, 1929, to January, 1936; as Diocesan Notary from October, 1929, to January, 1936; as Diocesan Director of Socialities from October, 1929, to January, 1940; as Associate Editor of The Catholic Light, diocesan weekly, from 1929 to 1933.

He has also served as Secretary of the Clerical Fund, Secretary of the Board of Consultants, Diocesan Consultant Vice-Officials and later Officials of the Diocesan Tribunal, and Episcopal Representative for Religious. He was appointed Vicar General on Dec. 7, 1933, and has been pastor of the Cathedral for nine years.
