### SPANISH LANGUAGE BANNED BY JAPANESE INVADERS

CHUNGKING, China.—The Rev. Mark Tennien, Maryknoll mission procurator in this city, reports that the Japanese have abolished the Spanish Language in the Philippine Law Courts, making Japanese the official language, but temporarily recognizing English.

An Italian News Agency in commenting upon this fact declared that the abolition of Spanish must be considered as the first step in connection with the reexamination of religious problems in the Philippines and the Japanese intention to bring back the entire archipelago.

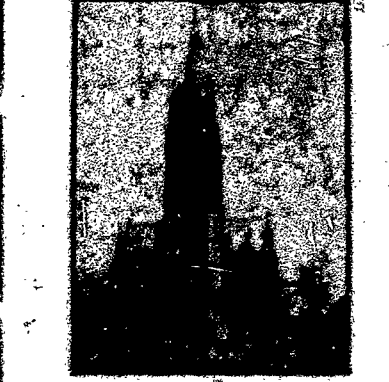
