### On USO-NCCS Front

## Provides Colored Slides of the Mass

WASHINGTON - (NC) Sound and color slides of the Mass are being distributed among USO clubs throughout the country operated by the National Catholic Community Service to provide an intimate study of the Holy Sacrifice in 80 colored pictures.

The slides have been made from a booklet, "Your Mass Visible," by the Rev. W. G. Keeler, of Loras College, Dubuque.

The headquarters of the National Catholic Community Service have sent ten sets of the slides to regional directors, who, in turn, make them available to the clubs in their respective areas. The headquarters also has distributed 25,000 copies of the booklet, "Your Mass Visible."

The narrator of the slides is the Rev. John M. Brady, of the School of Religion, De Paul University, Chicago, who explains the actions of the priest. The program of liturgical music is directed by the Rev. Emmet Kelly, Dean of Loras College Conservatory of Music, Dubuque and the organ accompaniment is by Dr. Edward Eigenschienck, American Conservatory of Music, Chicago.

In the booklet, "Your Mass Visible," an explanation is given under each of the 80 pictures with the Common prayers read at Mass and the Proper prayers for the Feast of Corpus Christi, also the prayers of the Mass for the dead with the final absolution prayers.

## General Eisenhower Lauds Camp Shows

NEW YORK As the USO-Camp Shows company wound up its first tour of American reservations in England and Ireland, almost the first expression of gratitude to reach USO President Chester I. Barnard came from Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower, Commanding General of the United States Army in the European theater of war.
